

Complaints have been received regarding the length of the crime report. To address these concerns, an executive summary highlighting the most important points has been compiled. For those requiring more details, the full report will follow the executive summary.

Executive Report: JSRA Security and Crime Overview - January 2025

Security Activities

Key Successes

- Vehicle Recovery:**
 - JSRA Security officers, in coordination with the JSRA Control Room, identified and intercepted a possible stolen vehicle in the Simonswyk area.
 - The suspects and vehicle were handed over to SAPS.
- Suspicious Activity Investigations:**
 - Two individuals searching trash bins were found in the Karindal area. Upon further investigation, a stolen trash bin was recovered. The owner chose not to open a case, and the suspects were warned.
 - A similar incident was reported in Rozendal, where the complainant also opted not to open a case.
- Theft Investigation and Arrest:**
 - A stolen cell phone case in Mostertsdraai led to JSRA Control Room identifying a suspect through surveillance footage.
 - The suspect was later recognized by security officers, leading to an arrest and SAPS case opening.

Other incidents: Lost/found goods, lost dogs, open vehicles, keys locked in vehicles, water leaks, streetlights out of order, medical cases, fire, car accidents, house-breakings, theft, traffic offenses, public alcohol abuse, and disorderly conduct.

- No reported incidents** of murder, attempted murder, robbery, sexual assault, or public indecency.

Property-Related Crime

- **House-breaking:**
 - Three cases reported (two in Mostertsdrift, one in Jonkershoek Valley).
 - Items were stolen; no pattern in occurrence timing.
- **Vehicle-Related Crime:**
 - No vehicle/motorcycle thefts.
 - Two thefts out/from vehicles (Mostertsdrift and JSRA Extension area).
- **General Theft:**
 - Four reported incidents of general theft, including stolen trash bins and a stolen cell phone leading to an arrest.
 - One case of theft out of a bag that was left unattended.

Other Criminal Incidents

- **Common Assault:** A child was struck by an individual in Uniepark. Surveillance footage was analysed, and a possible suspect vehicle was identified.
- **Fraud Cases:** Three reported fraud incidents (one in Rozendal, two in JSRA Extension area) involving unauthorized transactions.
- **Stolen Vehicle Recovery:** A possible stolen vehicle was identified and recovered in Simonswyk with JSRA assistance.
- **Assault and Property Damage:** One case each of serious assault and malicious damage to property in Jonkershoek Valley.

Safety Recommendations

- Avoid isolated areas and travel in groups when hiking, jogging, or cycling.
- Be vigilant around ATMs.

Die JSRA Sekuriteitsbeamptes het die volgende suksesse behaal:

JSRA Sekuriteitsbeamptes het 'n versoek gekry om uit te kyk vir 'n vermoedelik gesteelde voertuig. Die voertuig is met behulp van die JSRA Beheerkamer en JSRA Sekuriteitsbeamptes opgemerk in die Simonswyk-omgewing. Die voertuig is afgetrek. Die verdagtes en voertuig is aan die SAPD oorhandig.

Die JSRA Sekuriteitsbeamptes het twee persone in die Karindal-omgewing opgemerk wat in die vuilgoedddromme krap. Hulle het 'n asdrom by hulle gehad en by verdere ondersoek van die JSRA Beheerkamer is vasgestel dat die asdrom vermoedelik gesteel is. Die eienaar van die asdrom is in die Simonswyk-omgewing opgespoor, maar die persoon wou nie 'n saak open nie. Die verdagtes is gewaarsku en daarna laat gaan. Daar was 'n soortgelyke voorval in die Rozendal-omgewing waarby die klaer ook nie 'n saak wou open nie. Die JSRA doen 'n ernstige beroep op inwoners om asb sake te open by die SAPD.

Die JSRA het 'n klage ontvang van 'n selfoon wat vermoedelik uit 'n woning in die Mostertsdrift-omgewing gesteel is. Die JSRA Beheerkamer het die kameras in die omgewing nagegaan en 'n moontlike verdagte geïdentifiseer. Die verdagte is 'n paar dae na die voorval deur die JSRA Sekuriteitsbeamptes herken en aangekeer. Die klaer het 'n saak by die SAPD geopen en die verdagte is aan die SAPD oorhandig.

Die JSRA Beheerkamer het die kameras in die omgewing nagegaan en 'n moontlike verdagte geïdentifiseer. Die verdagte is 'n paar dae na die voorval deur die JSRA Sekuriteitsbeamptes herken en aangekeer. Die klaer het 'n saak by die SAPD geopen en die verdagte is aan die SAPD oorhandig. Daar was 'n verdere voorval op 'n Maandagmiddag, waar die klaer haar sak langs 'n veld gelos het en toe sy terugkeer na haar sak was items uit die sak geneem. Verdagte/s onbekend.

Die volgende sake is ook onder die aandag van die JSRA gebring.

Een saak van Aanranding gewoon is onder die JSRA se aandag gebring. Twee kinders het op go-scooters in die Uniepark-omgewing gery, waarna 'n w/m by hulle gestop het en die een seun op die skouer geslaan het. Die seuns het vermoedelik aan die verkeerde kant van die pad met die go-scooters gery. Die videomateriaal in die Uniepark-omgewing is nagegaan en 'n voertuig waarin die w/m gery het, is geïdentifiseer. Die inligting is gestoor vir verdere ondersoekdoeleindes. Die voertuig betrokke is vermoedelik 'n wit Nissan NP200 met CLxxxxx nommerplate.

Die volgende sake het in die omgewing van die Informele Nedersetting in die Jonkershoekvallei plaasgevind :

Een saak van Aanranding met die doel om ernstig te beseer.

Een saak van Opsetlike saakbeskadiging.

Een saak van bedrog in die Rozendal-omgewing, waar die klaer na bewering gekontak is deur 'n bank se bedrogeenheid en versoek is om geld oor te plaas na 'n ander rekening, omdat daar na bewering verdagtes besig was met 'n onwettige transaksie.

Een saak van besit van 'n vermoedelik gesteelde voertuig - JSRA Sekuriteitsbeamptes het 'n waarskuwing gekry mbt 'n vermoedelik gesteelde voertuig. Die voertuig is met behulp van die JSRA Beheerkamer en JSRA Sekuriteitsbeamptes in die Simonswyk-omgewing opgespoor. Die voertuig is afgetrek. Die verdagtes en voertuig is aan die SAPD oorhandig.

Twee sake van bedrog is ook aangemeld in die JSRA 'Extension Area'. Beide voorvalle het op die onderskeie klaers se bankrekening plaasgevind terwyl hulle tuis was.

Maak asb seker as u 'n oproep van 'n bank se bedrogeenheid ontvang dat dit wel die bank is en nie verdagtes wat poog om toegang tot u bankrekening te kry nie.

A. Security activities

During the month the JSRA Security officers achieved the following successes:

The JSRA Security officers received a request to watch out for a possible stolen vehicle. The vehicle was observed in the Simonswyk area with the help of the JSRA Control room. And with the help of the JSRA Security officers the vehicle was stopped and the suspects and the vehicle were handed over to the SAPS.

The JSRA Security officers found two individuals who were searching the trash bins. They had a separate bin with them. Upon further investigation the JSRA Control room determined that the trash bin was probably stolen. The owner of the bin was traced in the Simonswyk area, but preferred not to open a case. The suspects were warned and allowed to go.

A similar incident occurred in the Rozendal area, where the complainant also opted not to open a case. The JSRA urgently appeals to residents to open a case with the SAPS when such incidents occur.

The JSRA received a complaint of a cell phone which was probably stolen from a house in the Mostertsdrift area. The JSRA Control room scanned the cameras in the area and identified a possible suspect. A few days later the suspect was recognised by the JSRA Security officers and was arrested. The complainant opened a case with the SAPS and the suspect was handed over to them.

House-breaking	Three incidents of house-breaking were reported to the JSRA. Two of the incidents occurred in the Mostertsdrift area. With both incidents there is no specific day or time tendency, although both probably occurred during the weekend. In one incident the door of the outer room was opened. Items were taken and the suspect/s fled. In the other incident a window was probably opened wider, items were taken and the suspect/s fled. The other incident occurred on a Tuesday night in the Jonkershoek Valley. Items were taken and the suspect/s fled.
Theft of motor vehicle / motor cycle	No incident reported.
Theft from / out of a vehicle	Two incidents were reported to us. The one incident occurred on a Thursday afternoon in the Mostertsdrift area. The hub-caps of a vehicle were allegedly stolen. The incident was only reported to us in February. Suspect/s unknown. In the JSRA Extension area one incident was reported to us. It occurred on a Thursday late afternoon/early evening. The window of the vehicle was broken, items were taken. The suspect/s fled.
Theft general	There were four incidents of theft general in the JSRA area. The JSRA security officers found two individuals in the Karindal area who were searching the trash bins. They had a separate bin with them and on further investigation the JSRA Control room determined that the bin was probably stolen. The owner of the bin was identified in the Simonswyk area, but he was unwilling to open a case. The suspects were warned and allowed to go. There was a similar incident in the Rozendal area where the complainant also was unwilling to open a case. Both the incidents occurred on a Monday morning. The JSRA urgently requests residents to open cases with the SAPS. The JSRA received a complaint on a Thursday afternoon of a cell phone that was probably stolen from a house in the Mostertsdrift area. The JSRA Control room reviewed the cameras in the area and identified a possible suspect. The suspect was recognised a few days later by the JSRA Security officers and was arrested. The complainant opened a case with the SAPS and the suspect was handed over to them. There was another incident on a Monday afternoon. The complainant left her bag on the edge of a field. When she returned, items were taken from her bag. Suspect/s unknown.

The following cases were also reported to the JSRA.

One common assault incident was reported to us. Two children were riding in the Uniepark area on go-scooters. A w/m stopped and hit the one boy on the shoulder. The video material in the area was reviewed and the vehicle of the w/m was possibly identified. The information was saved for further investigation purposes. The vehicle involved is possibly a white Nissan NP200 with registration CLxxxxx.

The following incidents occurred in the area of the informal settlement in the Jonkershoek Valley:

One incident of assault with the purpose of causing serious bodily harm.

One incident of malicious damage to property.

One incident of fraud in the Rozendal area, where the complainant was presumably contacted by the fraud unit of a bank and requested to transfer money to another account, because suspects were trying to conduct an unlawful transaction.

One incident of a possible stolen vehicle. The JSRA Security officers were requested to watch out for a possible stolen vehicle. With the support of the JSRA Control room the vehicle was spotted in the Simonswyk area. The vehicle was stopped. The suspects and vehicle were handed over to the SAPS.

Two incidents of fraud were also reported in the JSRA Extension area. Both incidents entailed fraudulent actions on the complainants' bank accounts while the complainants were at home.

Please make sure when you receive a phone call from the 'fraud unit' of a bank that it is indeed the fraud unit of the bank and not suspects trying to gain entrance to your bank account.

C. Crime in areas adjacent to the JSRA (not JSRA area)

Please be on the alert when you visit the following areas.

Shopping centre bordering the JSRA	One incident of common assault was brought to our attention. The JSRA rendered support until the SAPS arrived to take over control. Please be on the alert for ATM fraud in the vicinity of ATMs.
Botmaskop/African Valley	No incident reported to us.
Helshoogte Road	One incident of attempted theft was brought to our attention. The JSRA vehicles rendered support when the suspects were on the premises. Unfortunately, the suspect/s fled.
Koloniesland River Area / 'Bergpad' behind Coetzenburg / Coetzenburg Stadium / Suidwal- / Noordwal-Wes area	Several incidents were reported to us. Please be on the alert for the following: Theft from / out of vehicles; Theft of vehicles; Theft general; Common robbery; Common assault; Armed robbery; Fraud; If you observe any suspicious activities / persons / vehicles, please contact the JSRA Control room without delay.
Jan Marais Park area	Several possible places of hiding/sleeping were identified by the community and handed over to Law Enforcement and the security in the Jan Marais Park area.

	The suspect/s of the one housebreaking that was reported above possibly gain entry to the property via the park.
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Please be on the alert when you visit these areas and NEVER GO ON YOUR OWN OR IN SMALL GROUPS when you hike / jog / cycle. You should preferably go in large groups. Also be on the alert at all ATMs when you withdraw money.

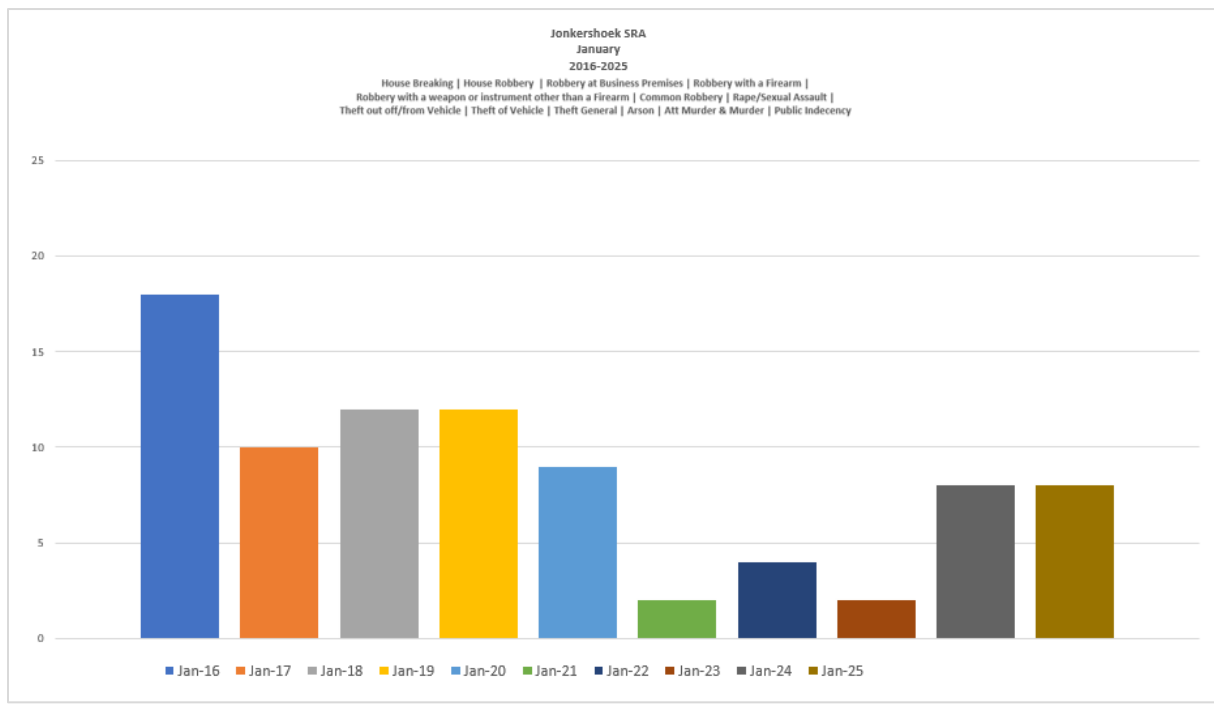

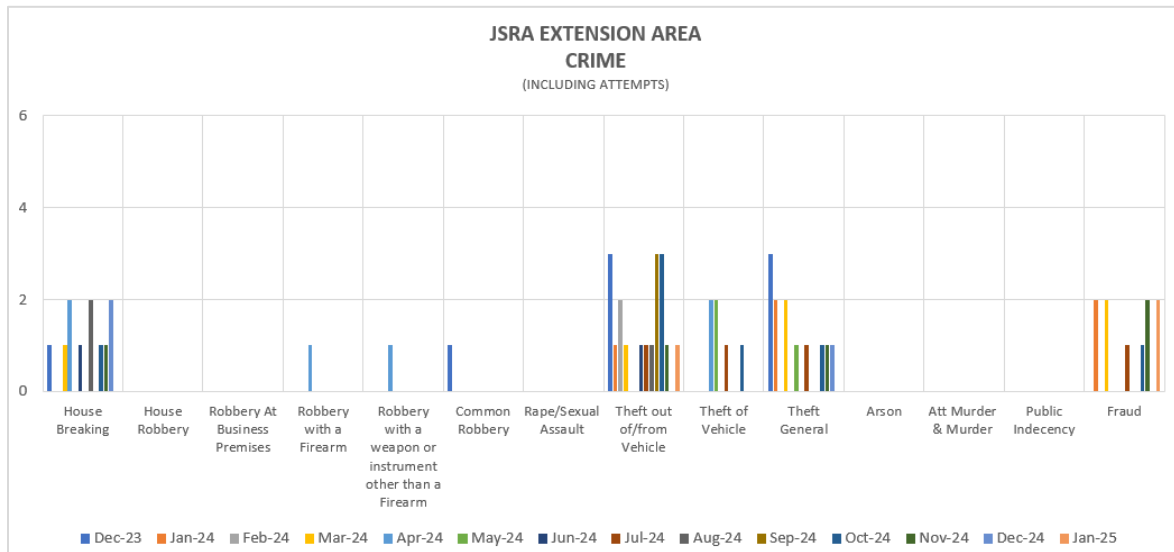
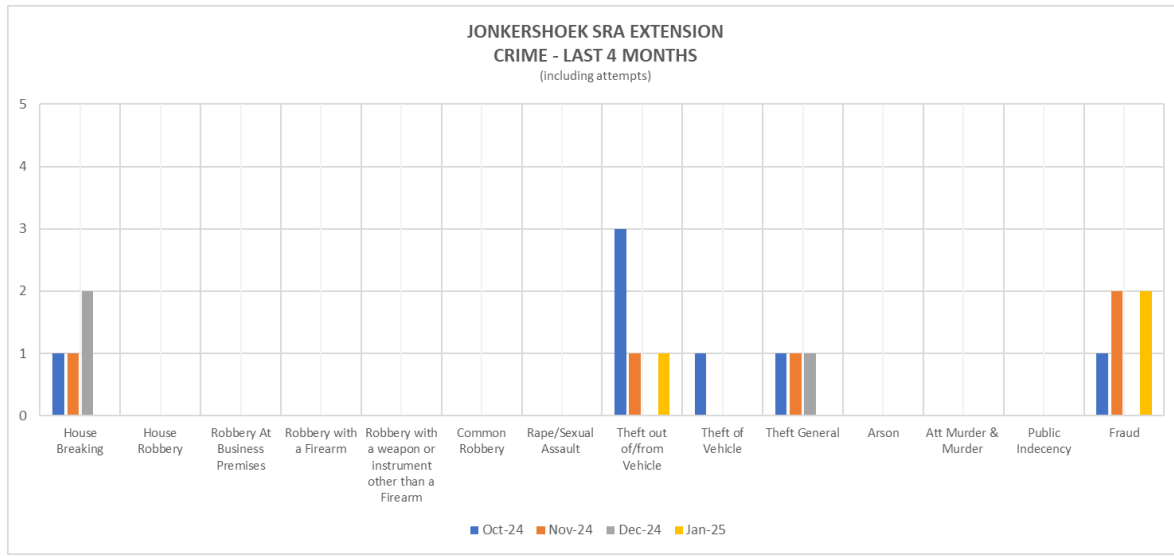
