Executive Summary Report JSRA Security and Crime Overview – February 2025

Security Activities

Key Successes

- **Attempted Robbery Arrest**
 - A group of juveniles attempted to rob a resident in Simonswyk using a knife.
 - The JSRA security team responded swiftly, apprehended the suspects, and handed them over to SAPS.
 - A criminal case for attempted robbery with a weapon other than a firearm was opened.
- **Theft general**
 - Two individuals were seen fleeing a property in Simonswyk.
 - JSRA officers intercepted them and found them in possession of suspected stolen property.
 - The complainant chose not to open a case, and the suspects were warned and released.

- **No reported incidents** - Murder / Attempted Murder, House Robbery, Business Robbery, Armed Robbery (Firearm), Common Robbery, Sexual Assault / Rape, Public Indecency
- **Armed Robbery (Other Weapon)** – One attempted robbery in Simonswyk involving a knife. Suspects were arrested.

Property-Related Crime

- **House-breaking**
 - A house-breaking was reported in Mostertsdrift.
 - Suspects gained entry by breaking a window and fled with stolen items.
 - A white Hyundai (CAA registration) was identified as a suspect vehicle; security footage was secured for SAPS investigation.
- **Vehicle-Related Crime**
 - **Theft of Motor Vehicle** – One case in Murray/Neethling Street (Toyota Fortuner stolen during the day).
- **General Theft**
 - **Incident 1:** Two individuals apprehended in Simonswyk with suspected stolen property. Complainant declined to press charges.
 - **Incident 2:** A hiker in Jonkershoek Nature Reserve reported their phone missing.
- **Modus Operandi Alert – Uniepark House-Breaking**
 - A house-breaking incident in Uniepark highlighted the following modus operandi used by suspects:
 - Suspects likely gained entry from the front of the property rather than the back, avoiding security beams.
 - They climbed onto the roof, removed tiles, and disabled the alarm system before entering.
 - The house-breaking occurred most likely on the evening of 28 February, when the security system reported a fault at 22:39.
 - The JSRA is reviewing CCTV footage from the surrounding area to identify potential suspects.

Die voorval het op 'n Vrydag vroege in Simonswyk plaasgevind. Die klaer en 'n vriend het verby 'n groep jong kinders gestap, waarna een van hulle 'n mes uitgehaal het. Die klaer het in die woning ingehardloop en die JSRA in kennis gestel. Die JSRA Voertuie het onmiddellik gereageer. Die verdagtes is aangekeer en die een persoon was in besit van 'n mes. Volgens die verdagte wat die mes uitgehaal het, wou sy nie die persone beroof nie, maar het sy dit net vir die grap gedoen. Al vier verdagtes wat betrokke was, is aan die SAPD oorhandig. Die verdagte voertuig se besonderhede is net na die voorval aan die SAPD, Wetstoepassing en ander Sekuriteitsvennote deurgegee. Daar is ook met die speurder gepraat en die inligting m.b.t. die voertuig wat betrokke was, is aan haar deurgegee. Verder ter inligting: Op 1 Maart 2025 is die JSRA in kennis gestel van 'n huisbraak in die Uniepark-omgewing. Die voorval sal by Maart 2025 se statistiek bygewerk word. Die JSRA wil alle inwoners waarsku in verband met die Modus Operandi van die voorval: Die eienaar van die woning het op 28 Februarie om ongeveer 16:15 die perseel verlaat en die alarm geaktiveer. Die volgende dag, op 1 Maart om ongeveer 14:00, het die persoon wat na die diere omsien, opgemerk dat daar moontlik 'n inbraak plaasgevind het. Na verdere ondersoek en bevinding deur die eienaar van die woning word daar vermoed dat die verdagtes nie van agter af oor die heining geklim het en die alarmstrale ("beams") omseil het sonder om die alarm te aktiveer nie, maar eerder van vooraf toegang tot die dak van die woning gekry het. Die verdagtes het die dakteëls verwyder, 'n gat bokant die alarmtoestel gemaak en die alarmtoestel uitgeruk. Die alarmstelsel het op 28 Februarie 2025 om 22:39 'n foutsein na die sekuriteitsmaatskappy gestuur. Die diefwering by 'n venster en 'n deur is oopforseer. Items is geneem. Verdagte(s) is tans onbekend. Die JSRA beskik nie oor sekuriteitskameras in die onmiddellike omgewing van die woning nie, maar kameras in die omgewing word nagegaan om moontlike verdagte(s) te identifiseer.

A. Security Activities

The JSRA security officers achieved the following successes:

One attempt robbery with a weapon other than a firearm was reported to the JSRA. The incident occurred in the early evening on a Friday in Simonswyk. The complainant and a friend walked past a group of young children when one of them produced a knife. The complainant ran into the house and informed the JSRA. The JSRA vehicles responded immediately. The suspects were apprehended and one person was found in possession of a knife. According to the suspect she did not intend to rob the person, but that she had done it as a joke. All four suspects were handed over to the SAPS. The complainant in the case opened a criminal complaint at the SAPS of an attempt robbery with a weapon other than a firearm.

On a Tuesday afternoon one of the JSRA vehicles observed two people running out of a premises in the Simonswyk area. The other JSRA vehicles rendered support and the two suspects were apprehended. They were found to be in possession of possible stolen property. The complainant in the case was contacted but he was unwilling to open a criminal case against the two suspects. They were warned and let go. The JSRA seriously appeal to residents to report criminal cases to the SAPS.

Armed robbery with a weapon other than a firearm	One incident of attempted robbery with a weapon other than a firearm was reported to the JSRA. It occurred in the early evening on a Friday in Simonswyk. The complainant and a friend walked past a group of young children, when one of them produced a knife. The complainant ran into the house and informed the JSRA. The JSRA vehicles responded immediately. The suspects were apprehended

	and one person was found in possession of a knife. According to the suspect she did not intend to rob the person, but that she only did it for fun. All four suspects were handed over to the SAPS. The complainant opened a criminal case with the SAPS of attempted robbery with a weapon other than a firearm.
Common robbery	No incident reported.
Rape / sexual assault	No incident reported.
Public indecency	No incident reported.

Property related crime:

House-breaking	One incident of house-breaking in the Mostertsdrift area was reported to the JSRA. Two suspects probably gained entrance to the house by breaking a window. Items were taken and the suspects fled. A white Hyundai with a CAA registration plate was presumably involved in the house-breaking. The cameras in the area were reviewed and all possible video material that can be linked to the incident was safed for further investigation purposes for the SAPS. The information was also shared with the that's investigating the case. Additional information: On 1 March 2025 the JSRA was informed of a house-breaking in the Uniepark area. The particulars of the incident will be included in the statistics of March. The JSRA would like to inform residents of the modus operandi in the incident: The owner of the residence left the house on 28 February at about 16:15 and activated the alarm. The next day, on 1 March, at about 14:00 the person taking care of the animals observed that there could have been a house-breaking. Upon further inspection and observation by the owner it is suspected that the suspects did not gain entry from the back fence and by crawling without the beams detecting them. The suspects possibly gained entry from the front and then climbed on the roof. The suspects removed roof tiles, made a hole above the alarm device and removed the alarm device from its position. The alarm sent a fault signal at 22:39 on 28 February to the security company. The burglar proofing of a window and a door was forced open and items were removed. The suspect(s) are currently unknown. The JSRA does not have security cameras in the direct vicinity of the house, but cameras in the area are scanned to try and identify suspect(s). General security hints: (These are general recommendations and are not linked to the specific house-breaking.) • Activate your alarm system when you leave the premises and when you go to bed.
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	- It is recommended that you install a movement sensor in your roof to provide additional security. - When your house alarm goes off, please do not investigate on your own. Rather contact your security company to inspect your premises. - In case of an emergency or suspect activity, you are welcome to contact the JSRA control room for support. 📞 JSRA Control Room: 062 027 1601 If you have any further questions you are welcome to send an e-mail to manager@jonkershoekjsra.co.za Upon further investigation it was established that there were probably another two similar incidents in other areas outside the JSRA area.
Theft of motor vehicle / motor cycle	One incident of theft of a vehicle was brought to the attention of the JSRA. The incident occurred on a Tuesday during the day. The complainant in the case parked her vehicle, a Toyota Fortuner, in the morning in the Murray / Neethling Street area in Stellenbosch. Upon return in the afternoon the vehicle was gone. The complainant opened a case of theft of a vehicle at the SAPS. The theft of vehicle was only reported to the JSRA two weeks later. The JSRA urgently requests residents to report incidents and complaints to the JSRA as soon as possible in order that possible suspects can be identified and information be collected.
Theft from / out of a vehicle	No incident reported.
Theft general	Two incidents of theft general were brought to our attention. The one incident occurred on a Tuesday afternoon in the Simonswyk area. A JSRA vehicle observed where two people were running out of a premises. The other JSRA vehicles rendered support and the two people were apprehended. The items that were probably stolen were found in their possession. The complainant in the case was contacted but he was unwilling to open a criminal case against the suspects. The suspects were warned and allowed to go. The JSRA again appeals to residents to report criminal cases to the SAPS. The other incident occurred on a Sunday during the day in the Jonkershoek Valley. The complainant and friends went hiking in the Jonkershoek Nature Reserve. The complainant hid his cell phone underneath his shirt and upon return it was gone.

The following incidents were also brought to the attention of the JSRA.

One incident of common assault occurred at the informal settlement in the Jonkershoek Valley on a Sunday night.

Two cases of Crimen Injuria.

One case of a traffic violation according to the National Road Traffic Law (Category A) on a Wednesday morning in the Simonswyk area.

One case of malicious damage to property on a Friday night in the Simonswyk area.

One case where a suspect was arrested by the SAPS for being in possession of a dangerous weapon.

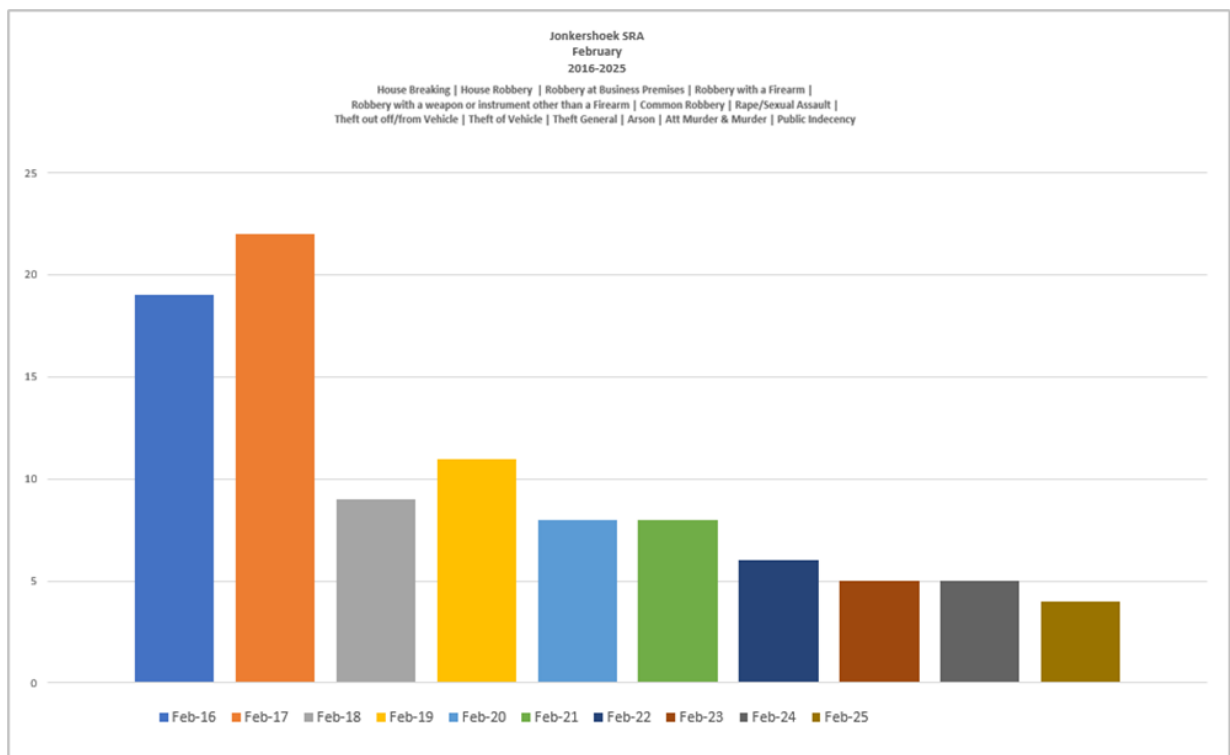
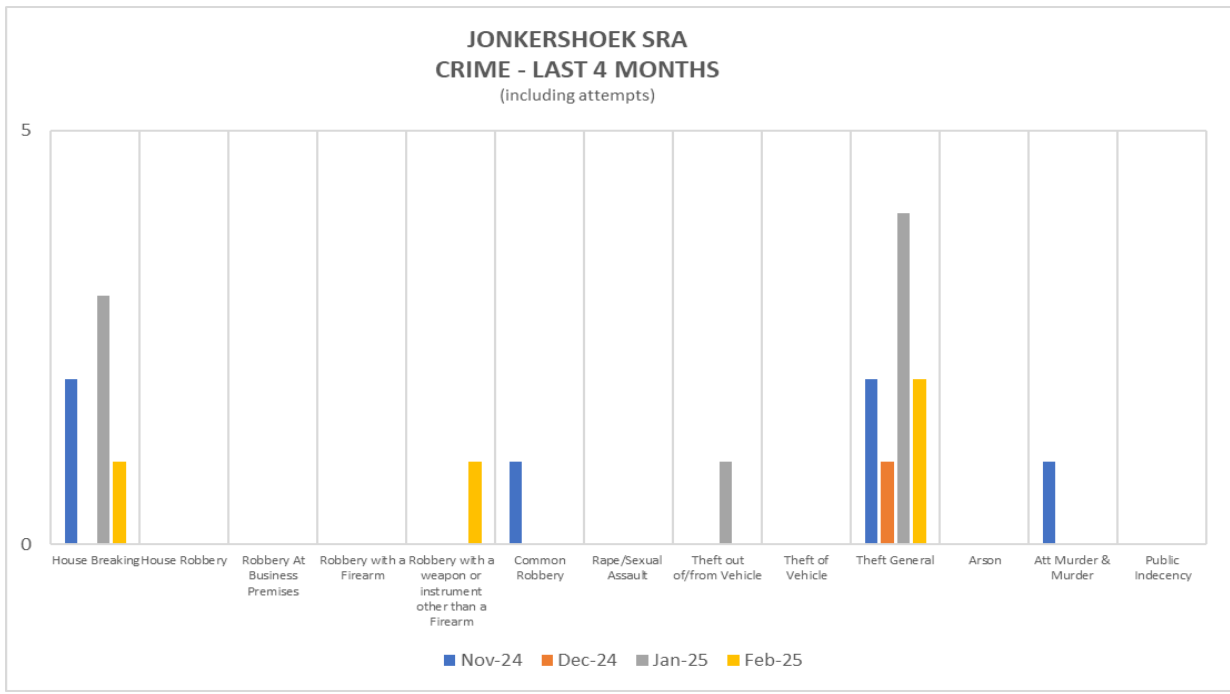
General safety hints:

- In connection with the Modus Operandi that was identified in Uniepark it is recommended that you consider installing an alarm eye in your roof.

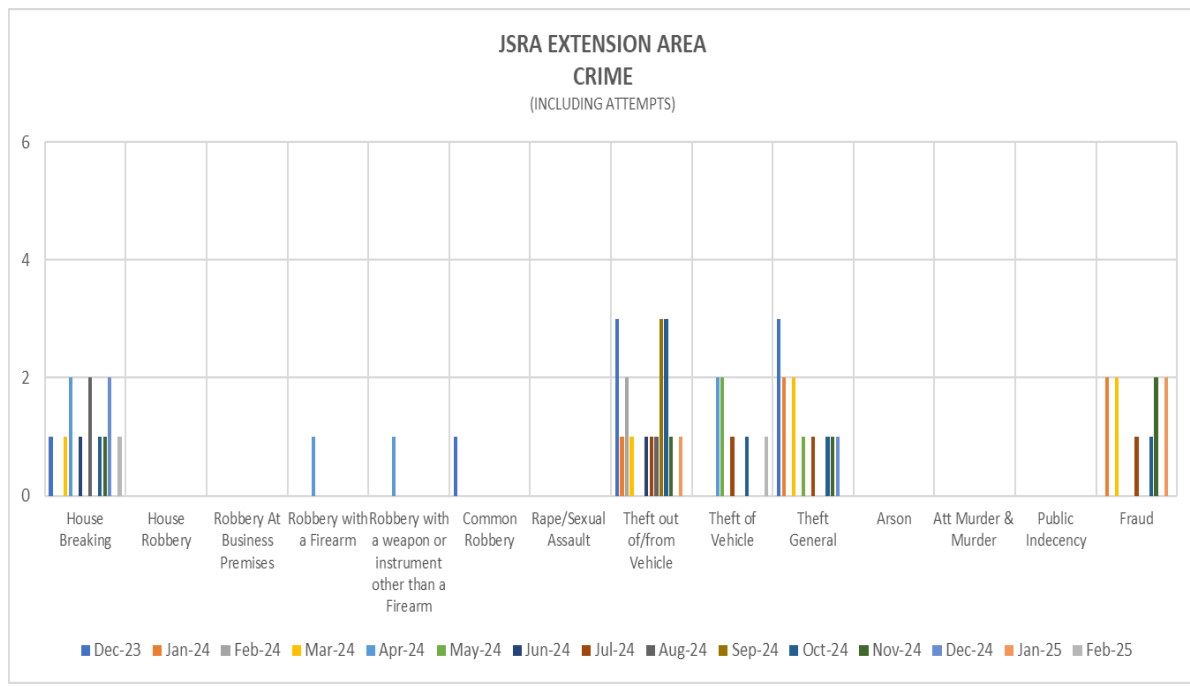
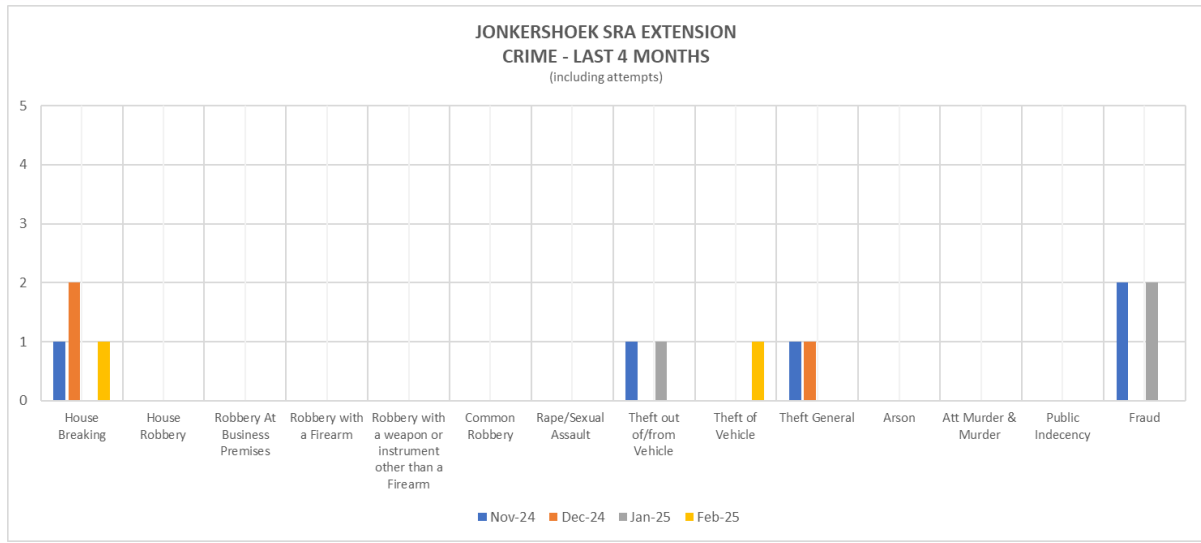
